THE ORGANIZATION

Kings River Conservation District is a leading water, power, and environmental resource management agency in Fresno, California. The Manager of Water Resources position reports directly to the Deputy General Manager of Water Resources. Typical assignments include managing and performing complex water resources work in any phase of the District's resource programs.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidates for this position will be persons who have the ability to:

- Represent the District in a positive, professional, and courteous manner
- Plan, organize, direct, and review the work of others
- Communicate effectively orally and in writing
- Analyze situations and take appropriate action

Additionally, the ideal candidate will have knowledge of:

- Theory and practices related to the development and management of a wide variety of projects associated with regional water resources, including management of grants and contracts
- Principles and techniques of supervision and personnel management
- Computer systems and software packages commonly used in the water resources field to manage projects and analyze data

SIGNIFICANT DUTIES

- Manage the performance of water quality and water supply activities for the District including planning, development, and implementation of strategies and procedures
- Represent the District in various local, state, and national forums, conferences, meetings or legislative hearings regarding water resource management and ground and surface water quality issues
- Manage programs or regulatory activities related to water policies and issues affecting the District or related coalitions
- Coordinate and communicate pertinent information regarding legal matters, legislation, regulations, policies, and programs to District staff, governmental and non-governmental bodies, and other entities or group served by the District
- Assist with management of District efforts to facilitate Kings and Tulare Lake Subbasin compliance with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act
- Lead and assist in water resources activities and projects related to surface and groundwater projects including water quality, water supply, subsidence, land use, hydrology, conveyance, and irrigation systems
- Develop and/or oversee fiscal operating and capital expenditure budgets pertaining to District water quality activities, staff, and other efforts managed by KRC D
- Assist in management of grants

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Any combination of education and experience that will provide the necessary knowledge and abilities will be considered acceptable.

Education: Graduation from an accredited four-year college with a Bachelor's Degree with major coursework in engineering, environmental, agriculture, business, or resource planning

Experience: A minimum of four (4) years of water resources related experience inside or outside of District employment
