The Board will be requested to increase the Professional Services budget by \$190,000 and authorize the General Manager or Appointee to execute an agreement with Stantec to prepare a Feasibility Study and advise and assist staff with further evaluation of Raising Pine Flat Dam, Rogers Crossing and Mill Creek development.
