The Kings River Water Association Water Master, Steve Haugen, reported on water storage on the Kings River System, inflow and outflow at Pine Flat

Reservoir, and the available flood control space on the system. Directors' questions were addressed.

6. <u>Directors' Reports</u>

Director Yoshimoto reported on his visit to the Columbia River Gorge and Bonneville Power House.

7. Business Operations Report (Trevarrow / Merritt)

Brian Trevarrow, with input from David Merritt, provided the Board with a financial position update; the August 2022 Fund Statements; and overall District administrative updates. Directors' questions were addressed.
