- Perform concrete, asphalt, and pavement repairs
- Operate pneumatic, hydraulic, and gasoline powered tools such as pavement breaker, clay spade, tamper, vibrator, chain saw, and compactor
- Load and unload materials and equipment from service trucks
- May learn semi-skilled maintenance, repair, welding, and construction work in an assigned work area
- Perform brush clearing, weed and pest control functions, and basic landscape maintenance
- Respond to 24-hour flood patrol emergencies on the Kings River
- Clean, operate, and maintain vehicles, tractors, and power-operated equipment
