### **Procurement of 245kV Class High Voltage SF6 Breaker**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

Bidders shall include the following Sections in their Bid in the order of requirements listed below. A Section Heading shall be included for each of the requirements, each section separated by a full Word document insert page, titled with the section headings in bold letters below.

1. **Full Technical Description of the HV SF6 Breaker Proposed-** including applicable Data Sheets and Brochures, including that of the accessories and instrument transformer(s) specified in the technical specification document.
2. **General Outline and Layout Drawings.**
3. **Contact Details of Key Personnel-** contact details of personnel for correspondences.
4. **Proposed Location of Manufacturing**
5. **Experience List-** List of five (5) recent projects with similar installations with reference contacts for the project owner.
6. **Proposed High Level schedule** showing- total lead time, including engineering period, manufacturing and testing, until ready to ship to site.
7. **Price Itemization** – Include a table to itemize the following  
Product price, sales taxes, tariffs, custom duty, site supervision labor cost.  
(Note that KRCD is not exempt from California State or Fresno County taxes).  
  
7.1. Option Price line item for- site work involving removal of existing HV Oil Circuit Breaker and installation labor for new SF6 breaker, including a high-level installation schedule.
8. **Bidder's Terms and Conditions.**
9. **List of Exceptions and Clarifications-** itemized each exception and clarification with short explanation, as applicable.
10. **Alternate Equipment Proposal** (if none, indicate "None" for this section), that could effectively offer a better product than traditional 245kV class SF6 breaker. An alternate proven technology can be proposed as well- technology shall have installed base and be in continuous service for at least past 10 years, at least at 5 different power plants or substations.

11. **Bid Bond-** A Bid must be accompanied by Bid security made payable to Owner (KRCD), in an amount of 10 percent of Bidder's maximum Bid price and in the form of a certified or bank check or a Bid Bond issued by a surety.
