

JEFF L. TAYLOR PINE FLAT POWER PLANT
PROCUREMENT OF 245kV CLASS HIGH VOLTAGE SF6 BREAKER

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that electronically submitted bids will be received until the hour of **2:00 PM Pacific Standard Time (PST), February 12, 2026** on www.bidnetdirect.com platform **Solicitation number: 203.02.101**, the web-based bid posting platform used by Kings River Conservation District (KRCD), herein after referred to as Owner, for the procurement of a 245kV High Voltage SF6 Breaker, as more fully described in the Bid Technical Specifications.

Bidders may send questions regarding the bid in the form of Request for Information (RFI). Last date for RFIs submission is January 20, 2026 by 4:00 PM PST. All RFIs shall be emailed to KRCD Director of Power Resources, Pawan Niroula at pniroula@krcd.org, with an email subject line "PF 203.02.101-RFI (short RFI description)".

Bids will be evaluated by Owner's panel and will thereafter be accepted or rejected by the Owner within 90 days. The owner may opt to implement a two-stage selection process and may only select three (3) to four (4) qualified bidders to move forward with detailed bid evaluation process.

Bids are requested for design, furnishing and delivery of (one) outdoor, dead tank, SF6, power circuit breakers, 245 kV voltage class including all accessory equipment and material to replace the existing 245kV oil circuit breaker located at the existing outdoor switchyard at the Jeff L. Taylor Pine Flat Power Plant owned by KRCD.

Bid documents shall be downloaded from the web-based platform www.bidnetdirect.com. Bid documents consist of this Invitation for Bids, Procurement Specification, Instructions to Bidders, and Existing Drawings. Bidders are informed that these documents will be required in the preparation of bids. Each bid must be submitted as per described under Instructions to Bidders.

Bidder must deposit with his Bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions stated in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidder will be required to submit with his Bid evidence of their qualifications to perform the Work satisfactorily- required bid submittals are outlined in the Instructions to Bidders document. The Successful Bidder must furnish a Performance Bond in the amount of the total Bid.


Owner reserves the right in its sole discretion after opening bids to waive any and all irregularities in any bid, to reject any or all bids, or to award the Contract to the responsible

bidder. The award of the Contract, if it is awarded, will be made within one hundred-twenty days after the final bid submission date.
